#### PROPOSAL

Demolish a ca. 1949 house.

#### ARCHITECTURE

Two-story rectangular-plan, side-gabled frame house with 6:6 fenestration, and full-width shed-roofed independent porch. All the siding and windows have been removed.

#### RESEARCH

The address does not appear in city directories before 1953, and there is no evidence of a building permit for this site in city records. A garage apartment was built on this property in 1937, but it seems that the garage apartment was between the house that used to be at 514 E. Annie and the current house. When the current house at 514 E. Annie was built, the garage apartment was demolished. The first owners and occupants of the house were Woodrow and Jean Townsend, who lived here until the late 1950s. He was a meterman and then foreman at the City Booster Station. The house became a rental unit after that, with a wide variety of tenants and relatively high turnover.

#### STAFF COMMENTS

The house does not appear in any City survey.

#### STAFF RECOMMENDATION

Release the permit.


