

ORDINANCE NO. 20130509-010

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE FISCAL YEAR 2012-2013 AUSTIN CONVENTION CENTER OPERATING FUND OPERATING BUDGET (ORDINANCE NO. 20120910-001) TO PAY A FINAL JUDGMENT RELATING TO THE CONDEMNATION OF LOTS 1-8, INCLUSIVE, OF BLOCK 38 OF THE ORIGINAL CITY OF AUSTIN, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AUSTIN:

PART 1. The Council amends the Fiscal Year 2012-2013 Austin Convention Center Operating Fund Operating Budget (Ordinance No. 20120910-001) to increase revenue in the amount of \$1,820,000 from funds currently in the registry of the Travis County District Court relating to the case of City of Austin v. Harry M. Whittington, et. al. (Cause No. D-1-GV-07-00942), a condemnation case involving lots 1-8, inclusive, of Block 38 of the Original City of Austin.

PART 2. The Council amends the Fiscal Year 2012-2013 Austin Convention Center Operating Fund Operating Budget (Ordinance No. 20120910-001) to increase expenditures by \$6,325,000 to pay the final judgment in City of Austin v. Harry M. Whittington, et. al. (Cause No. D-1-GV-07-00942).

PART 3. The Council amends the Fiscal Year 2012-2013 Austin Convention Center Operating Fund Operating Budget (Ordinance No. 20120910-001) to decrease the ending balance by \$4,505,000 to pay the final judgment in City of Austin v. Harry M. Whittington, et. al. (Cause No. D-1-GV-07-00942).

PART 4. The Council finds that the need to fund this judgment that has just been entered constitutes an emergency and a grave public necessity to meet an unusual and unforeseen condition that could not have been included in the original budget.

PART 5. This ordinance takes effect immediately.
