

Community Transformation Grant



Year 2 / Partnership with HHSD – Heather & Meg are funded through CTG Grant and our work primarily revolves around completing these deliverables

- Implement plan to increase the number of urban farms, community gardens, farmers' markets and /or farm-to-site programs in areas of high need.
 - Compilation of integrated GIS platform for Austin's Local Food System
 - Food & Farm Educational Summit (9/21/13)
 - Collaborative work to establish more opportunities for agriculture
 - Mini-grant Program – coming May – August 2013; offering \$2,500 grants to organizations promoting sustainable food production and healthy food access in Austin. This program will run similar to HHSD's mini-grant program

Community Transformation Grant



- Collaborate with a multi-departmental team to draft a procurement plan to increase the percentage of healthy and local food purchasing in all City of Austin departments.
- Provide technical assistance to the multi-departmental City team about healthy and local food procurement and to PARD during the transition to 50% healthy vending policy
- Assist in increasing the number of existing joint use agreements that provide physical activity and recreation opportunities throughout Travis County.
- Facilitate implementation of community-led health programs and initiatives in the Dove Springs area.
- Assist with working groups' planning and development related to the Imagine Austin Comprehensive Plan.
