

Council Audit and Finance Committee Special Called Meeting WEDNESDAY, May 8, 2013

MINUTES

THE AUSTIN CITY COUNCIL AUDIT AND FINANCE COMMITTEE CONVENED ON WEDNESDAY, MAY 8, 2013 AT 12:35 P.M. IN THE BOARDS AND COMMISSIONS ROOM, FIRST FLOOR, ROOM 1101, CITY HALL, 301 W. 2nd STREET.

The meeting was called to order at 12:35 p.m. by Chair Sheryl Cole. In attendance were Council Member Laura Morrison, Council Member Kathie Tovo, and Council Member Bill Spelman.

Jason Hadavi, Chief of Investigations, presented CAIU update, management response to CAIU investigations regarding misuse of city resources and acceptance of raffle prizes, and comparative statistics related to fear of retaliation. Mark Washington, Human Resources Department Director, presented the evidence of retaliation in the workforce. Audit and Finance Committee (AFC) members asked multiple questions of Hadavi, Washington, and John Steiner, Assistant City Attorney, source for the legal opinions regarding the raffle prizes discussed, and former Ethics Officer supervising the survey discussed in Hadavi's presentation. AFC members requested City management to attend a future AFC meeting to address AFC members' concern about the Ethics resource center's survey not distributed to the City of Austin's Council and management. Also, AFC members expressed interest in revised City policy addressing the raffle prizes.
