SUBJECT: Auditorium Shores Special Events Venue Options

As you are aware, the Parks and Recreation Department (PAR) is working with C3 Presents (C3), the organizer of the Austin City Limits Music Festival, and with the Austin Parks Foundation (APF) on a proposed public-private partnership (P3) that if approved by Council in the upcoming weeks, will result in the City's ability to expedite certain structural and aesthetic improvements to Auditorium Shores, consistent with the 1999 master plan.

The PAR Office of Special Events (PAR-OSE) began notifying event organizers in 2009 verbally, through periodic meetings, and each year in writing (via annual event contracts) that future Auditorium Shores park improvements were forthcoming. Event organizers were advised to anticipate a direct impact to future event bookings at this site and to begin searching for alternative sites for their events due to scheduled construction. The consistent message to organizers was that Auditorium Shores would be closed for construction at some point in the near future and therefore, organizers should proactively plan alternative sites to accommodate their events. Staff continued to provide periodic updates to organizers at any point the project scope evolved and information was made available.

A full project briefing was provided to organizers in early May, 2013, following the Parks and Recreation Board meeting concerning the proposed public-private partnership and construction schedule. Organizers were informed that the recommendation for this partnership was scheduled to move forward for City Council consideration. PAR-OSE began actively consulting with event organizers and staff of the Palmer Events Center, Long Center, Travis County Expo Center, Camp Mabry, AISD, and Circuit of Americas. Staff's goal is to help identify and convey all possible venue options to organizers, including connecting them with other event property owners. The final event bookings will require the organizers to execute independent contracts with the event property owners. The PAR will continue to work with event organizers and provide an additional update prior to Council action scheduled for June 6, 2013.
