THERE ARE NO CHANGES IN THE PROPOSED LOCAL AMENDMENTS COMPARED TO THE CURRENT ORDINANCE THAT HAVE AN INCREASE TO RESIDENTIAL CONSTRUCTION. THE PROPOSED CHANGES REFLECT THE SAFETY REQUIREMENTS FOR STRUCTURE THAT HAVE ROOF TOP ACCESS, ALLOWS OPTIONS TO ELECTRICAL CONNECTION, INCREASE ENERGY EFFICIENCY.
