Authorize award, negotiation and execution of a 12-month requirements service contract with SYPHERLINK INC., for maintenance and support for Sypherlink computer software to standardize crime records for the Austin Police Department in an amount not to exceed \$77,824 with four 12-month extension options in amounts not to exceed \$78,214, \$78,605, \$78,998 and \$79,393 respectively for a total contract amount not to exceed \$393,034.

Amount and Source of Funding

Funding in the amount of \$77,824 is available in the Fiscal Year 2012-2013 Operating Budget of the Austin Police Department. Funding for the extension options is contingent upon available funding in future budgets.

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Additional Backup Information

This contract is for maintenance and support of software for the Austin Police Department that converts and standardizes crime records from partner agencies. APD has partnered with other law enforcement agencies in Central Texas to implement a combined crime records data set that is used to more quickly identify criminals. The Sypherlink software transforms the records from the partner law enforcement agencies into a record layout that has been adopted by all the agencies involved. This standardization ensures that records are consistent and accurate.
