Additional Backup Information

The City will negotiate and execute this interlocal agreement (Memorandum of Understanding) with The University of Texas at Austin (University) for the installation of wayfinding signs within the City street right-of-way. The City desires to accommodate the installation of these signs as a benefit to the drivers and pedestrians visiting the University.

The project consists of one or multiple sub-projects to be implemented pursuant to the agreement and located adjacent to and in the vicinity of the University campus.

The University will be entirely responsible for the manufacturing, installation, and on-going maintenance of the wayfinding signs. The University will notify the City of new sign installations within the City's right-of-way and will follow all requirements about utilities location prior to excavation.

The City will review and inspect the installation and the restoration of the sidewalks after installation is completed.

The cost of the Project is entirely the responsibility of the University.
