### PROPOSAL

Demolish a ca. 1954 house.

### ARCHITECTURE

One-story, rectangular-plan, front-gabled frame house with a minimal front-gabled, partialwidth entry porch on the left side of the front façade; Colonial Revival-styled 8:8 and 6:6 fenestration; non-historic front-gabled carport extends from the left half of the front of the house.

## RESEARCH

The house was built in 1954 by a local builder, and has been a rent house for most of its existence. Tenants include students and teaching assistants at the University of Texas. The only owner-occupants of this house were Walter and Mattie McDavid, who lived here in the late 1950s and early 1960s. Both were attendants at Austin State Hospital.

### STAFF COMMENTS

The house does not appear in any City survey.

### STAFF RECOMMENDATION

Encourage relocation over demolition, but release the permit. The house has neither the architectural nor the historical merit to warrant individual landmark designation.
