

THIRST INSTALLATION

PARD CONTRACT REQUIREMENTS

PARD will require the following stipulations will be in the contract for the installation of THIRST, should it move forward in its approvals

- a. Presentation and approval by the Land & Facilities Committee, the Navigation Committee and approval by Parks Board
- b. Presentation and approval by other COA departments including but not limited to Street and Bridge and Watershed Protection.
- c. Submission of any and all drawings for PARD review regarding the movement of material or equipment on PARD property associated with the installation of the 'Floating Tree' and the 'Prayer Flags'.
- d. Review and coordination of set up, installation, siting duration and tear down procedures to include trail re-routes, current users of the surface waters of Lady Bird Lake and the Roy and Ann Butler Trail, additional construction projects planned or proposed at areas identified in the proposal and coordination with city agencies overseeing public safety and welfare in the area identified for installation.
- e. Submission of any and all permits associated with the installation of all or part of the temporary art piece 'Thirst'.
- f. PARD to issue 'notice to proceed.'
- g. Location and attachment of any portion of the proposed 'Prayer Flags' shall be reviewed by PARD staff including PARD Forestry, PARD Rangers and PARD Operations and Maintenance personal prior to installation.
- h. No harm or damage of existing trees shall be acceptable to PARD. Any harm or damaged observed on existing trees associated with the installation of the 'Prayer Flags' shall be mitigated in conjunction with the City of Austin Environmental Code and mitigation recommendations by PARD Forestry.
- i. Any material associated with the 'Prayer Flags' found on PARD property not secured partially or wholly to the art piece 'Thirst' will be considered liter and will be discarded by PARD Maintenance and Operations.
- j. Any material associated with the 'Prayer Flags' in the opinion of PARD Maintenance and Operations, Rangers, Forestry and Office of CIP Project Management and Administration as potential safety hazard will be removed and discarded by PARD immediately. Notification to Women and Their Work will be provided after removal.

- k. The Donor will hire 24 hour security should a security risk related to the installation become apparent by way of an incident or threat of an incident. The Parks Department will also have the right to ask the Donor to remove the work.
- l. Project will be reviewed by PARD officials at 6 weeks into the installation to determine if the installation will be extended for another 6 weeks.
- m. Public Relations plan will include Women & Their Work as the first responders to media requests and AIPP/EGRSO as second responders.
