This contract will provide the Public Works Department with various lengths, gauges, and configurations of steel reinforcing bar (rebar) to be purchased on an as-needed basis. Rebar is used as a tensioning device in the construction of concrete and masonry structures. By itself, concrete is a material that is very strong in compression, but relatively weak in tension. To compensate for this imbalance in concrete's behavior, rebar is cast into it in order to carry tensile loads. This combination allows for concrete to be made into almost any shape and size. The Public Works Department will primarily be using this material for new construction and repairs, including sidewalks, street pavements, driveway approaches, curbs and gutters, and retaining walls.
