Approve an ordinance accepting \$75,000 in grant funds from the State of Texas, Office of the Governor, Criminal Justice Division; and amending the Fiscal Year 2012-2013 Police Department Operating Budget Special Revenue Fund (Ordinance No. 20120910-001) to appropriate \$75,000 for the Austin Police Department Regional Training Project. **Additional Backup Information**

This ordinance will accept \$75,000 in grant funding from the State of Texas, Office of the Governor, Criminal Justice Division and will amend the FY 2012-2013 Police Department Operating Budget Special Revenue Fund of Ordinance No. 20120910-001 to appropriate said funds for the project entitled APD Regional Training Project.

Funding from the State of Texas, Office of the Governor, Criminal Justice Division will be used to send law enforcement personnel to training and to locally host public safety trainings on topics such as violent crime interview and interrogation techniques. All training will take place during the project period of September 1, 2013 – August 31, 2014.
