This with Lakeside Equipment Corporation is for the purchase of a replacement screening cartridge of the Austin Water Utility's (AWU), Hornsby Bend Wastewater Treatment Plant. The cartridge will be used to replace cartridge on existing Lakeside Raptor Fine Screen Sludge Screening equipment at the Bar Screen Facility.

At present, Hornsby Bend has only one operating unit, and needs repairs due to excessive flows and loading which caused extensive damage to the basket and rake assembly, the main assemblies in the unit. The unit is used to remove rags and grit to prevent material from entering the plant and causing further equipment damage.

Lakeside Equipment Corporation, Bartlett, IL, installed the original screener in the 90's and is the sole manufacturer and proprietary designer of the RAPTOR Fine Screens supplied for the Hornsby Bend Facility. The cartridge being purchased is the only one that can be used on the original patented equipment and can be retrofitted on the existing equipment.
