ORDINANCE NO.

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CITY CODE CHAPTER 8-1 TO ADD THE DEFINITION OF INFLATABLE FLOTATION DEVICE, TO ADD A PROHIBITION ON THE USE OF INFLATABLE DEVICES ALONG A PORTION OF THE COLORADO RIVER, TO AMEND CITY CODE SECTION 8-1-72 RELATED TO BOATING CONCESSIONS, AND TO CREATE AN OFFENSE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AUSTIN:

PART 1. City Code Section 8-1-1 (*Definitions*) is amended to add the following, and to renumber the remaining definitions accordingly:

(5) INFLATABLE FLOTATION DEVICE means an inner tube or other water recreational form or apparatus that is inflated with air or foam or is non-navigable. This term includes inflatable chaise loungers, air mattresses, and other inflatable devices.

PART 2. City Code Chapter 8-1 (*Parks Administration*) is amended to add a new Section 8-1-3 to read:

§8-1-3 PENALTY.

- (A) A person who violates a provision of this chapter is guilty of a separate offense for each day the violation of this chapter continues.
- (B) Each offense is punishable by a fine not to exceed \$2,000. A culpable mental state is not required for fines of \$500 or less, and need not be proved.

PART 3. City Code Chapter 8-1 (*Parks Administration*) Article 5 (*Town Lake Park*) is amended to add a new Section 8-1-64 to read:

§8-1-64 INFLATABLE FLOTATION DEVICES.

(A) Except as provided in Subsection (B), a person may operate, use, or otherwise ride in an inflatable flotation device in Town Lake Park.

(B) A person commits an offense if he operates, uses, or otherwise rides in an inflatable flotation device on the Colorado River, between Longhorn Dam and U.S. Highway 183.

PART 4. City Code Section 8-1-72 (*Boating Concessions*) Subsections (B), (C), (D), (E), and (F), are amended as follows:

§8-1-72 BOATING CONCESSION.

- (B) On Town Lake, between Tom Miller Dam and Lamar Boulevard, a person <u>must</u> [may] obtain a concession:
 - (1) to rent to the public a boat designed for recreational rowing, including a canoe, racing shell, or rowboat:
 - (2) to operate an excursion boat; or
 - (3) to maintain a landing for an excursion boat that is not a permanent mooring.
- (C) On Town Lake, between Lamar Boulevard and Congress Avenue, a person <u>must</u> [may] obtain a concession:
 - (1) to rent to the public a boat that requires little or no skill to operate, including a paddleboat;
 - (2) to operate an excursion boat; or
 - (3) to maintain a permanent mooring for an excursion boat.
- (D) On Town Lake, between Congress Avenue and Longhorn Dam, a person <u>must</u> [may] obtain a concession:
 - (1) to rent to the public a boat designed for recreational rowing, including a canoe, racing shell, or rowboat;
 - (2) to operate an excursion boat; or
 - (3) to maintain a permanent mooring for an excursion boat.

In the river basin immediately upstream from Longhorn Dam, a person must (E) [may] obtain a concession to rent [to the public] a sailboat to the public to the public. On the Colorado River, between Longhorn Dam and U.S. Highway 183, a (F) person must [may] obtain a concession to rent [to the public] a boat designed for recreational rowing that can withstand swiftly flowing water and fluctuating water levels, including a rowboat, fishing boat, or johnboat to the public. A person may not obtain a concession to rent inflatable flotation devices. PART 5. This ordinance takes effect on _ . 2013.
