Authorize negotiation and execution of an amendment to the professional services agreement with COTERA + REED ARCHITECTS to provide architectural services through 2011 through 2013, or until financial authorization is expended, to complete the design of the joint Park Ranger and Park Police Headquarters, in the amount of \$338,000 for a total contract amount not to exceed amount of \$6,168,000.

Funding is available in the Capital and/or Operating and Maintenance Budgets of the various departments requiring services.

Additional Backup Information

Design and programming of the existing PARD building, close to the downtown trails and the Nash Hernandez building, had begun, with Cotera + Reed Architects for PARD use. In response to the creation of the 24-hour trail system and the passing of the 2012 Bonds, the design of this building is transitioning to house the joint Park Ranger and Park Police Headquarters. This new facility will house both the Park Rangers and Park Police to facilitate better coordination and communication. Additional authority is needed to complete the design for transition of the building, which was included in the 2012 bond program.

The design team is familiar with the location, the building standards, and the current condition of the facility. This includes: knowledge of existing conditions related to architectural finishes; knowledge of the structural, mechanical, electrical and plumbing systems; and knowledge of the building's audio and visual technology design. This familiarity will enable them to expedite the design process while maintaining the conceptual integrity of the facility.

This amendment has been approved by the City's Change Control Committee.
