I see you have Williamson County on the agenda again tonight while you may be selecting your Mapping Consultant. Would like to add the following point in response to a heated question that Comm. Costello asked of Ed English:

Avery Ranch is a neighborhood community of interest, all to the east of 183, but the western edge of Avery Ranch is served by Leander School District, and most of the rest of Avery Ranch to the east of there is served by the Round Rock School District. NWAC would prefer that Avery Ranch all be kept together with the Williamson County precincts in the NW District that NWAC presented to the ICRC.
