The following items were acted on in a combined motion.

1. Approve the minutes of the June 6, 2013 Board meeting of the Austin Housing Finance Corporation.

The minutes for the Austin Housing Finance Corporation meeting of June 6, 2013 were approved on Board Member Martinez' motion, Board Member Spelman's second on a 7-0 vote.

2. Approve a resolution reappointing Humberto Lumbreras, Elizabeth A. Spencer, and Rebecca Giello to the Boards of Directors of the Arbors at Creekside Non-Profit Corporation, the Austin Inner-City Redevelopment Corporation, the Villas on Sixth Non-Profit Corporation, and the AHFC Village on Little Texas Non-Profit Corporation for terms expiring on July 28, 2016.

Resolution No. 20130808-AFHC002 was approved on Board Martinez' motion, Board Member Spelman's second on a 7-0 vote.

3. Approve the negotiation and execution of a loan in the amount of \$2,250,000 to FOUNDATION COMMUNITIES, INC. to assist with the purchase of a 29-acre tract at 3226 West Slaughter Lane for the purpose of constructing 138 units of mixed-income rental housing.
