Scope:

IT Risk Assessment:

- Use industry standard to benchmark (ex. COBIT, ISO, ITIL)
- Develop tool to allow staff to assess progress
- Make recommendations on priorities
- Develop with staff mitigation plans, business cases, roadmaps

IT Governance (decision making)

- Evaluate against world class performance benchmarks & key stakeholder expectations
- Develop tools to evaluate progress (ex. dashboards)
- Make recommendations on priorities
- Develop with staff improvement plans business cases and roadmaps
