
Issues and Concerns


- Increased growth is imminent and greater focus must be placed on the demands of the neighborhoods.

- Provide a foundation for interaction and better communication with Neighborhood Planning Contact Teams - NPCT.


A view of ANC Sector 9 and 10 boundaries

- Proposed boundary line 183 North to the Colorado river 183 South County line.


ANC Sector Map








Neighborhood Contact Teams - NPCT

- Address Connectivity and Mobility under the Imagine Austin Plan.


Request and Action

Suggestions to ICRC


- Request for HOA's and NA's to review current boundaries and make updates as needed.

AGR PLAN MAP




Travis County Commissioner Precincts with VTDs
