PROPOSAL

Demolish a ca. 1938 house.

ARCHITECTURE

One-story, rectangular-plan, side-gabled, random-patterned, ashlar stone-veneered frame house with a partial-width, front-gabled, wood entry hood; 1:1 fenestration. The house has a carport to the right of the main block of the house.

RESEARCH

The house appears to have been built in 1938 by Fred and Ruby Badger, who lived here for the rest of their lives. As a young man, Fred Badger worked as a steamfitter at the Confederate Home; he then became a tailor in the 1930s, and by the time he and Ruby moved into this house, he was a dyer and clothes cleaner for Kelly Smith Cleaners. By the late 1940s, he was the vice-president of Kelly Smith Cleaners, and by the late 1950s, he was the superintendent there. His son, Bill, lived next door, at 3606 Clawson Road, a house that has been demolished. His first wife, Ruby, passed away in 1965, and Fred re-married; he passed away in 1976, and his second wife, Margie, lived in this house until her death in 1992.


STAFF COMMENTS

The house is beyond the bounds of any city survey.

STAFF RECOMMENDATION

Encourage relocation over demolition, but release the permit upon completion of a City of Austin Documentation Package, consisting of photographs of all elevations, a dimensioned sketch plan, and a narrative history of the property, for archiving at the Austin History Center.

BIOGRAPHICAL NOTES

Fred D. and Ruby Badger (ca. 1938 – ca 1965)

Fred D. and Ruby Badger appear in the 1930 U.S. Census as the renters of a house at 610 E. 3rd Street in Austin. Fred D. Badger was then 29 years old, had been born in Texas, and was a tailor. Ruby Badger was then 33 and had been born in Texas. She had no occupation listed. They had a son, Billie, 3, who had been born in Texas. The 1920 U.S. Census shows F.D. Badger as a 19-year old steam engineer (plumber) at the Confederate Home in Austin.

Thursday in a local hospital. Besides her husband, Fred D. Badger, she is survived by her mother, Mrs. Martha McConnell; daughter, Mrs. Louise Ellen, all of Austin; son, William D. Badger, Las Vegas, Nev.; two sisters, Mrs. S. Gershon, California, and Mrs. M. Lamperson, Dallas; brother, James Grubbs, Austin, and two grandchildren.
