Mr. Tounget,

I am Vice-President and Treasurer of the Covered Bridge Property Owners Association in Oak Hill. Our Association is a member of both OHAN and of ANC.

I am sincerely concerned about the proposed district lines proposed by ICRC. Oak Hill is a unique and contiguous area, clearly marked by natural boundaries and as a "Community of Interest". The serious needs for services by the City of Austin have long been ignored by the council in favor of the central city areas.

Dividing Oak Hill into two council districts represents a continued dilution of the needs and concerns of this community.

The map presented by the Oak Hill Association of Neighborhoods (OHAN) was developed with compliance to the Federal Voting Act and with a goal of keeping Oak Hill and the Southwest part of the city in a single district. There is no "Community of Interest" between Oak Hill and Onion Creek and no logical basis for dividing Oak Hill into two districts

I strongly recommend that the ICRC recognize the OHAN proposed district map. While subject to adjustments, it represents the needs and desires of the Oak Hill Community.
