## Subject

Authorize negotiation and execution of contract amendments with two providers of HIV-related services under the Ryan White Part C Outpatient Early Intervention Services Grant: AIDS SERVICES OF AUSTIN, INC., in the amount of \$23,821, for a total second year contract of \$176,761, with three 12-month renewal options in an amount not to exceed \$176,761 per renewal option, for a total contract amount not to exceed \$884,898; and CENTRAL TEXAS COMMUNITY HEALTH CENTERS-DAVID POWELL CLINIC, in the amount of \$29,987, for a total second year contract of \$503,414, with three 12-month renewal option, in an amount not to exceed \$503,414 per renewal option for a total contract amount not to exceed \$2,487,083.

# Amount and Source of Funding

Funding in the amount of \$53,808 is available in the Fiscal Year 2012-2013 Approved Operating Budget of the Health and Human Services Department (HHSD) Special Revenue Fund, Ryan White Part C HIV Early Intervention grant. The contract period is January 1, 2013 to December 31, 2013. The grant period is January 1, 2013 to December 31, 2013.

# Additional Backup Information

The City received a third and final grant award in the amount of \$946,572 from the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services for the Ryan White Part C Outpatient Early Intervention Services program. The final award is a combination of \$79,808 of carryover funds plus the remaining \$282,267 of the Part C base award.

The Austin Travis County Health and Human Services Department (HHSD) is the administrative agency for this grant. HHSD in collaboration with the Part C program partner organizations (AIDS Services of Austin, David Powell Community Health Center, Community Action, Inc., and HHSD Communicable Disease Unit) submits an

annual grant application for the continuation of funds for the project area. These organizations have collaborated on the Part C program application for over 20 years and collectively are identified as the Austin Part C Project Area for this grant program.

The Part C grant focuses on the delivery of community-based primary medical care, including ambulatory medical care provided by David Powell Clinic, oral health services provided by AIDS Services of Austin, transportation services provided by Community Action, Inc., and non-medical case management services provided by HHSD's Communicable Disease Unit. The Part C project area is a 10-county service delivery area which includes Travis, Bastrop, Blanco, Burnet, Caldwell, Fayette, Hays, Lee, Llano and Williamson counties.
