On behalf of the Downtown Austin Alliance, I am pleased to inform you that the DAA Board of Directors confirmed the DAA's 2013-2014 fiscal year (May 1, 2013 through April 30, 2014) budget for the Downtown Rangers program.

The total budget amount for wages, taxes, benefits and all other program expenditures is \$652,779. This amount was based on budget information submitted by the program supervisor to provide for a total of twelve fulltime-equivalent positions. We recognize, however, that in order for any wage increases to be approved, the Rangers positions must first be reclassified. We are working with Commander Dusterhoft to address this issue and would request that the reclassification process be conducted as soon as possible.

We greatly appreciate our ongoing partnership with the Austin Police Department, your support of the Rangers program, and your focus on downtown issues.
