Additional Backup Information

In order to modify or alter the existing speed limit of a street, Texas laws require that a traffic engineering investigation be performed. Traffic conditions, pedestrian routes and proximity to O. Henry Middle School were evaluated on West 10th Street by the Austin Transportation Department to determine if modifications were appropriate to improve the safety for the students attending O. Henry Middle School. Based on this investigation, the Austin Transportation Department recommends adding the following amendment to City Code Section 12-4-64(D) (Table of Speed Limits):

Add: 10th Street (West) from Exposition Boulevard to Wayside Drive (20 MPH Speed Limit).
