## Additional Backup Information

The Goodnight Ranch South annexation area (approximately 458 acres) is located in southern Travis County, approximately 670 feet east of the intersection of East Slaughter Lane and Old Lockhart Road. This area is currently in the city's limited purpose jurisdiction and is adjacent to the city's full purpose jurisdiction on the north and south sides of the tract. This area is undeveloped, zoned Planned Unit Development (PUD), and is being annexed in accordance with the owner's request and the regulatory plan that was adopted at the time of limited purpose annexation. This property is part of the Onion Creek Metro Park Improvement district, which covers all of Goodnight Ranch, and will help fund improvements on adjacent undeveloped City parkland.
