Subject

Approve an ordinance authorizing acceptance of \$65,770 in grant funds from the TEXAS DEPARTMENT OF FAMILY AND PROTECTIVE SERVICES, 78744 COMMUNITY YOUTH DEVELOPMENT GRANT, and amending the Fiscal Year 2013-2014 Health and Human Services Department Operating Budget Special Revenue Fund (Ordinance No. 20130909-001) to appropriate \$65,770 for the delivery of recreational services.

Amount and Source of Funding

Funding is available from the Department of Family and Protective Services (DFPS), 78744 Community Youth Development Grant (CYD). The grant period is September 1, 2013 through August 30, 2014.

Additional Backup Information

The 78744 Community Youth Development (CYD) Program, formerly known as Southeast Austin Community Youth Development (SEACYD), has been funded since 1996 by the Texas Department of Family and Protective Services (TDFPS). The goal of the initiative is to prevent juvenile delinquency through the provision of community based prevention and remediation programs in the Southeast Austin 78744 zip code area.

Grant Goal Priority Categories have been established for community-based programs for all youth who live in, and/or attend school in the 78744 zip code area, particularly targeting at-risk, disconnected youth. In accordance with the grant, the 2010-2011 Needs Assessment, and approval by the 78744 Community Collaborative Committee, the recommended programs and services are eligible to be funded under the grant.

HHSD's has released a Request for Applications(RFA) on August 26, 2013 to procure recreational organized sports services for the 78744 zip code area based upon the 2013 Community Strength and Needs Assessment which resulted in community surveys listing organized sports services as the number one priority. HHSD will award a contract to the winning proposal after the deadline listed in the RFA. This \$65,770 will be used to support delivery of the organized sport program in the 78744 zip code area for Fiscal Year 2014.
