ANALYSIS / **ADDITIONAL INFORMATION**: The City of Austin Parks and Recreation Department (PARD) seeks to increase diversity in our musical programming through the World Music Series, produced by the History Arts and Nature Division. PARD received approval to apply for grant funding from the Texas Commission on the Arts and was awarded a grant on September 5, 2013. The Artistic Fee Subsidy will pay Texas Folklife Resources to curate a polka festival, entitled "Polkapocalypse", featuring the Morales Boyz, Brian Marshall, Los Pinkys & Polkasonics and the Ennis Czech Boys. The concert will be presented at the Elisabet Ney Museum at 304 East 44th Street on November 23, 2013. A match of \$1397 is required. The matching funds will be provided by the General Fund for production expenses such as marketing expenses and rentals of audience amenities
