A City Council Resolution directed the City Manager to bring forward an ordinance that creates a special events team, implements the special events team, and addresses special events.						
This proposed ordinance adds a new chapter to Title 4 (Business Regulation and Permit Requirements) that will apply to special events and high capacity event venues.						

The proposed ordinance repeals Chapter 14-8 (*Temporary Closure for Right-of-Way E wnt*) and replaces it with a new Chapter 14-8 (*Temporary Closure for Right-of-Way E wnt*) that is consistent with the proposed special events ordinance.

For consistency reasons, the proposed ordinance amends Section 10-3-96 (*Temporary Food Establishments*); and repeals Section 14-6-3 (*Temporary Closure for a Street Festivity*).

The ordinance initiates code amendments for Chapter 25-10 (*Sign Regulations*) for temporary signs identifying a special event and directs the City Manager to process the code amendment.
