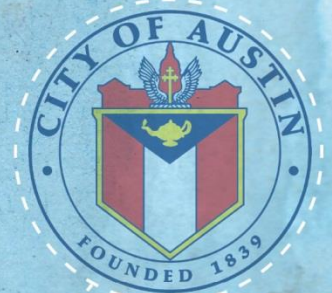

CONSTRUCTION TIME FRAME

- Oct 2013 to April 2014 (approximate dates)

CONSTRUCTION BUDGET

- \$ 2.7 million – Funded by the Parks and Recreation Department

MAJOR IMPROVEMNTS

- Upgrade outdated equipment and resources
- Resolve erosion issues
- Remove compaction to improve root conditions of heritage trees
- Create an Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) accessible path on the south side,
- Replace the gravel parking lot with new pavement

Work Sequence

Oct 28- Nov 4

- Staging- Fencing, Erosion Controls
- Surveying for control points
- Environmental Pre-Construction Inspection

Nov 11-15

- Demolition and clearing activities
- Fencing north side
- North lawn terracing
- Begin south woods grading
- Pads and curbs for new north bike racks
- Begin constructing new Hike and Bike Trail

Nov 11-15

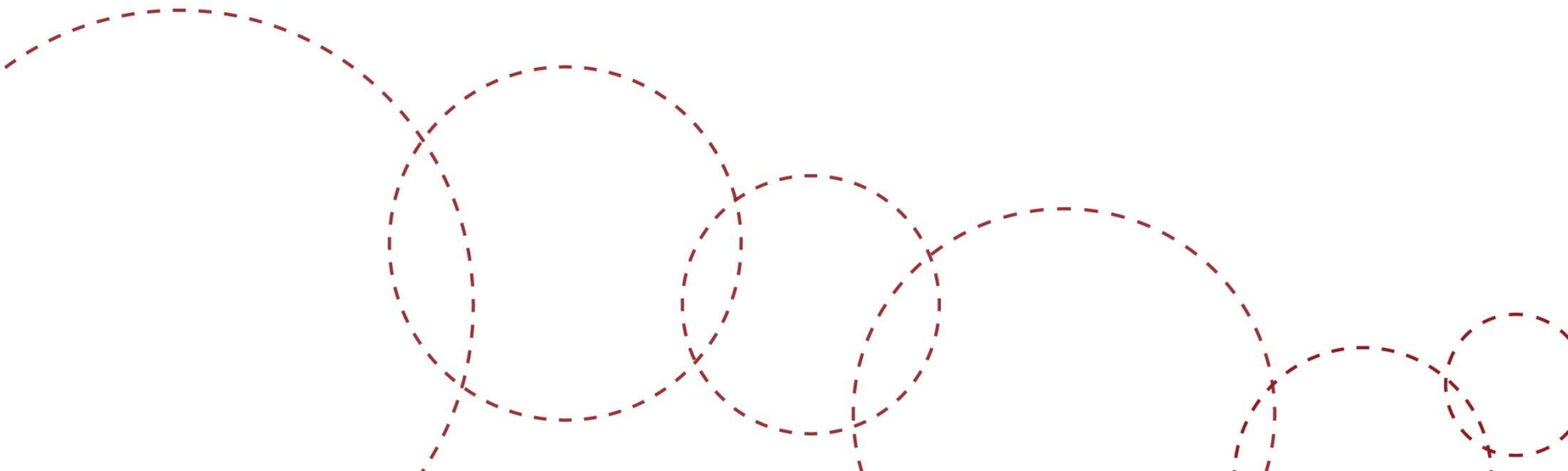
- New Hike and Bike trails
- ADA Ramps prep work
- South woods grading
- Installation of new storm sewer catch basins
- Start irrigation
