Survey Overview



**Issue:** Board needed community input to best advocate the needs of our neighborhood in the redistricting process

**Approach:** Survey conducted through SurveyMonkey, distributed to all active members of the neighborhood association, members of the listserv, visitors to [hpwbana.org](http://hpwbana.org) and the neighborhood Facebook page

## Survey Results: Key Issues

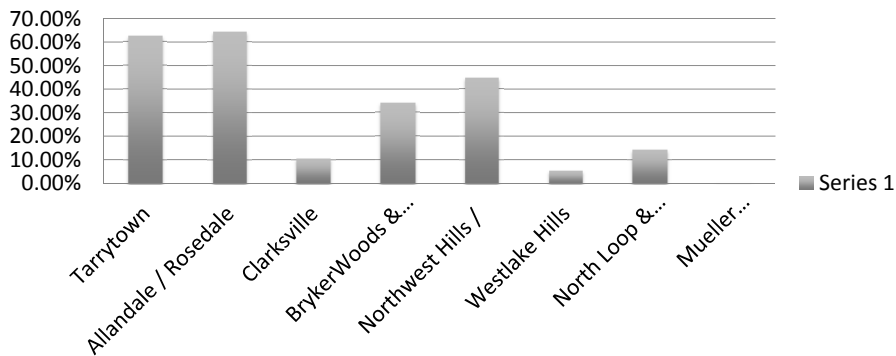
**Question 1:**

What are the key issues that you feel are of particular importance and relevance to our neighborhood? (for each, rate on a scale of 1-10, with 1 being of low importance / relevance, and 10 being of high relevance / importance)

Future development of state-owned properties	88%
MoPac Improvement Project	85%
Care for public green spaces and parks	80%
AISD schools	79%
Crime	76%
Water Conservation	73%
Wildfire risks	71%
Zoning	69%
In-fill development	60%
Stealth dorms	44%
Short-term rentals (STR)	44%

## Survey Results: Neighborhood Affiliations

**Q:** Which neighborhood(s) do you consider to be most similar to HPWBA in regards to which issues are relevant / important, and that would be most likely to share similar views on those issues?



## Conclusions



- The issues generating the most concern in HPWBANA are those that are consistent with central Austin concerns:
  - Future development of state-owned properties is a concern shared with Tarrytown (Austin State School, Camp Mabry), Rosedale and Allandale (Bull Creek Road state-owned property, Camp Mabry)
  - Mopac Improvement Project – it is hard to imagine that this issue will be of concern to the far reaches of District 10 as drawn in the Preliminary Map

## Conclusions



- Survey responses indicate that residents of HPWBANA recognize which areas share common concerns and issues
  - Over 60% indicated that Tarrytown, Rosedale and Allandale were more appropriate neighborhoods for HPWBANA to share a district with
