Why are T-406 and T-417, both which are in ONION CREEK and are placed in District 5 separated from the rest of Onion Creek which is in District 2? (Other than the fact that the white rich people in T-406 and T-417 don't want to be in a Hispanic district).

You've bifurcated a contiguous Onion creek. You've divided Onion Creek along ECONOMIC lines and makes the city set up for economic confrontation rather than working with each other in nearby neighborhoods.
