I and many hundreds of my neighbors were very happy with the first map proposed by the commission. However, we were greatly disappointed when the commission made significant changes to District 10. We are extremely concerned that the new map, which moves our boundary to include Tarrytown, Brykerwoods and Rosedale, will be very detrimental to our representation. We do NOT support the new map.

Northwest Hills and other neighborhoods north of 2222 have unique concerns: deer/coyotes/other wildlife, fire protection, zoning, transportation, etc., etc. Though we love and cherish our friends in Tarrytown and other older neighbors, our immediate northwest neighborhoods have very, very different concerns than the far-more-settled areas just south of us.

We were rejoicing in the thought that, finally, our part of town might have representation on the Austin City Council. We DO NOT think the new map achieves that representation and urge you strongly and fervently to go back to the earlier version that kept our communities of interest together by ending District 10 at 2222.
