1. C14H- 2013-0140

Louis C., Jr. and Virginia Nalle Page House

2507 Kenmore Court

Applicant: Sarah Crocker, Crocker Consultants

City Staff: Steve Sadowsky, Historic Preservation Office, 974-6454

Staff Recommendation: Recommend historic zoning.
