<p>Authorize award and execution of Amendment No. 1 to the contract with MILLER UNIFORMS &amp; EMBLEMS INC, for public safety and security uniforms and related services, to increase the funding on the current contract term in an amount not to exceed \$400,000, and increase the extension option in an amount not to exceed 600,000, for a revised total contract amount not to exceed \$6,625,235.</p>				
<b>Amount and Source of Funding</b>				
<p>Funding in the amount of \$102,564 is available in the Fiscal Year 2013-2014 Operating Budgets of the Code Compliance Department. Funding for the remaining 29-months of the original contract period and extension options is contingent upon available funding in future budgets.</p>

On February 14, 2012, a 60-month requirements supply contract was executed with Miller Uniforms & Emblems to provide brand-specific uniforms and related services for public safety and security department users in an amount not to exceed \$2,745,330 with one 60-month extension option in an amount not to exceed \$2,879,905, for a total contract amount not to exceed \$5,625,235.

This proposed contract amendment is to provide the Code Compliance Department with the same goods and services provided under this contract, including uniforms and alteration services to cover its forecasted requirements for the duration of the contract term.
