

**ORDINANCE NO. 20131121-062**

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 2-1-169 (D) OF THE CITY CODE TO SET A NEW DATE OF EXPIRATION OF THE ROBERT MUELLER MUNICIPAL AIRPORT PLAN IMPLEMENTATION ADVISORY COMMISSION.**

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AUSTIN:**

**PART 1.** The City Council finds that:

- (A) The City's volunteer boards and commissions improve the value of governance in the City by providing increased citizen input in the regulatory process.
- (B) The Robert Mueller Municipal Airport Redevelopment project welcomed its first residents and businesses in 2007, the redevelopment is close to 50% complete today, and it will be many years before the full development is completed.
- (C) The Robert Mueller Municipal Airport Plan implementation Advisory Commission provides valuable input and feedback toward the implementation of the plan, and the meetings will continue to provide a venue for important discussions between developers, city staff, and citizens.

**PART 2.** Section 2-1-169 (D) of the City Code (*Robert Mueller Municipal Airport Plan Implementation Advisory Commission*) is amended to read as follows:

- (D) The commission is abolished on [~~July 1, 2015~~] the date that the Master Development Agreement dated December 2, 2004, between the City and Catellus Austin, LLC expires or is terminated.

**PART 3.** This ordinance takes effect on December 2, 2013.




