This contract was awarded in compliance with City Code Chapter 2-9B (Minority Owned and Women Owned Business Enterprise Procurement Program) with 9.11% MBE and 9.04% WBE subconsultant participation to date.

Additional Backup Information

Construction for the Roy G. Guerrero Colorado River Park, located at 400 Grove Blvd in southeast Austin, began in October 2009. After construction delays, substantial completion was achieved in February 2013 and the park was opened to the public on July 1, 2013. Funding for this project is from the 1998 Bond Program.

The original construction contract duration was one year; however, construction delays extended the duration by an additional 2 ½ years. This amendment will fund the consultant's additional efforts required to mitigate construction delays, review and assist in negotiations with the contractor on change orders, provide construction phase services, and prepare and process a Site Plan Amendment which is necessary to close out the Site Development Permit.

The project is located in zip code 78702 and is managed by the Public Works Department.

This amendment has been approved by the City's Change Control Committee.

RVi (formerly Richardson Verdoorn) is located in Austin, TX.
