ANALYSIS / ADDITIONAL INFORMATION: The total amount of fees for waived for this event are not to exceed \$166,699. Additionally, the Austin Transportation Department refundable security deposits of \$4,000 and the Parks and Recreation Department refundable damage deposit requirements of \$3,500 are also being waived. Waiving fees for this event results in unrealized revenue for the Transportation Fund, Austin Transportation Department; General Fund, Parks and Recreation, Austin Fire and Health and Human Services Departments. Although budgeted revenue for fees is based upon historical data and not necessarily upon specific events, the waiver of these fees reduces potential revenues that could be realized.
