1. WHY ARE WE HERE?

- Make the Rainey Street Subdistrict eligible to participate in the Downtown Density Bonus Program (Resolution 20131017-032).

WHAT IS A DENSITY BONUS PROGRAM?

Incentive-based tool to grant additional entitlements (density) in return for community benefits.

Entitlements can include:

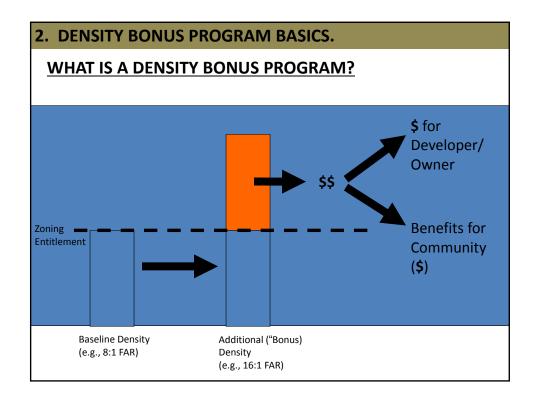
- Additional Density (FAR: Floor Area Ratio).
- Additional Units per Acre.
- Additional Height.

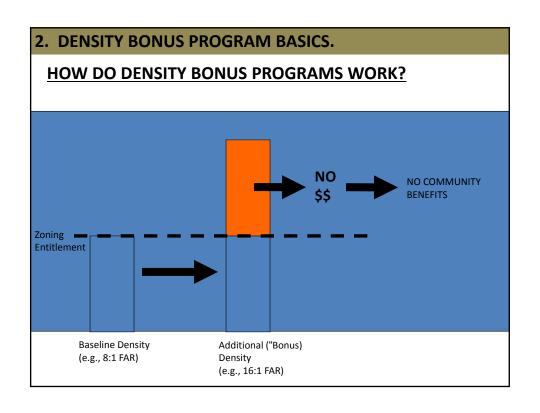
Community Benefits can include:

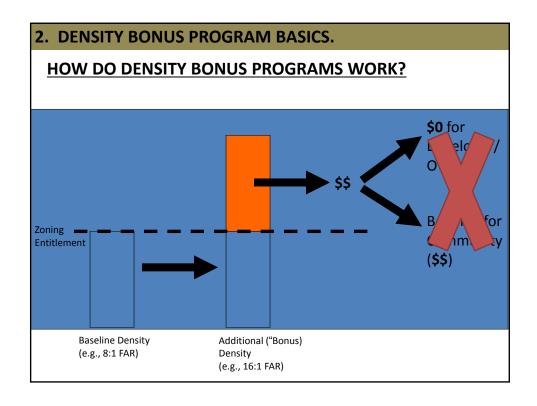
- Affordable housing (units or fee).
- Public open space.
- · Green building.

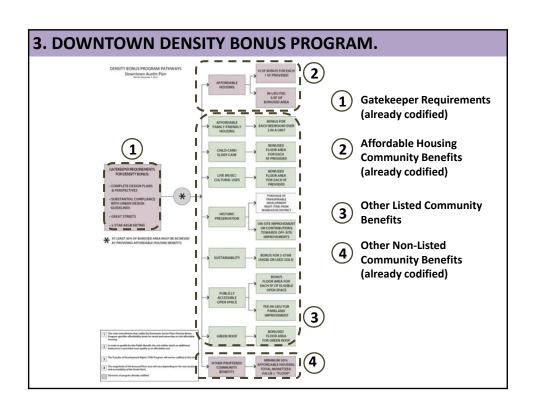

4. RAINEY SUBDISTRICT AMENDMENTS.

Affordability Period

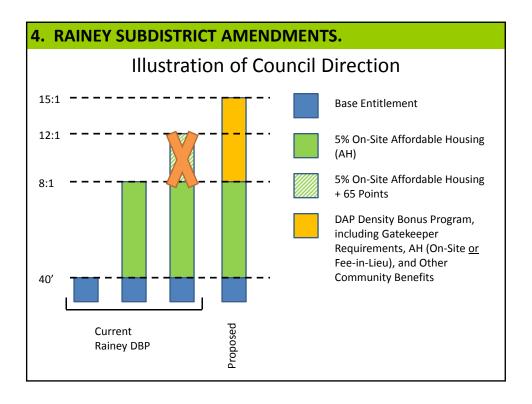
- Affordability period will be changed to 40 years for rental and 99 years for ownership.
- Affordable units will be reserved as affordable for the specified time periods through appropriate models such as shared-equity, monitoring, etc.



4. RAINEY SUBDISTRICT AMENDMENTS.

Include Rainey Street Subdistrict in Downtown Density Bonus Program

- Council Direction to modify Rainey Density Bonus Program (Resolution 20131017-032):
 - Rainey program to apply only up to 8:1 FAR;
 - Eliminate the existing Rainey program's "point system";
 - Apply Downtown Density Bonus Program for FAR between 8:1 and 15:1.
