



- Park Wide**
- Make sure that Park Rangers patrol the area for safety.
 - Provide many benches and trash containers along the Trail.
 - Install dog waste stations.
 - Keep the shoreline natural.
 - Make the park child- and family-friendly.
 - Keep the park pristine.
 - Allow for Informal use of areas instead of creating spaces for formalized activities.
- Boardwalk Landing Zone**
1. Provide trailhead concessions, like snacks and water.
 2. Minimize food concessions due to the trash that these produce.
 3. Provide water sports rental.
 4. Provide dock or viewpoints from land.
 5. Provide more bicycle parking.
 6. Farmers market would be nice in this area.
 7. Small events space for families of slightly larger groups.
 8. No amplified music.
 9. Free [unscheduled] activity area.
 10. No formal fields.
- Hostel and Concessions Zone**
11. Provide bicycle parking for concessions.
 12. Confine concessions to this zone.
 13. Do not add more concessions.
 14. Keep Hostel functioning at this location.
 15. No metered street parking – parking should be free for park users.
- The Peninsula Zone**
16. Keep this zone natural.
 17. Keep this zone quiet.
 18. Clear the invasives, especially ragweed.
 19. Protect the riparian zone.
 20. Build a new pedestrian bridge by dam instead.
 21. Keep the water and trail connections limited (i.e., don't allow continuous view - and dog access - to the water).
 22. Don't allow people on the Habitat Island off the tip of the Peninsula.
 23. Provide an outdoor classroom for canoers on the Habitat Island.
- The Basin Zone**
24. Protect riparian zone.
 25. Connect the trails from the new developments along Lakeshore to Butler Trail.
 26. Create a "food forest", with native trees like pecan, at the corner of Pleasant Valley and Lakeshore Blvd.
 27. Provide trail concessions like snacks and water.
 28. Make pedestrian crossing make safer and allow left turn from Lakeshore.
- Longhorn Shores Zone**
29. Keep/facilitate the fruit truck vendor.
 30. Create informal fields for pick-up games.
 31. Make picnic tables available for neighborhood use.
 32. Don't allow big festivals.
 33. Formalize edge of Pleasant Valley with parking, cycle tracks and sidewalks.
 34. Protect the riparian zone.
 35. Provide cycle tracks from Lakeshore Blvd. to Longhorn Dam on west side of Pleasant Valley Road.
 36. Maintain new trees and landscaping.
 37. Improve/widen the existing pedestrian tunnel.
 38. Create bicycle access from Riverside Drive to Cesar Chavez Street.
 39. Build new pedestrian bridge near Longhorn Dam.
- Surrounding Area**
40. Address the glare created from the Krieg Fields lighting.
 41. Austin Energy should reduce the glare from sports lights.
