

ORDINANCE NO.

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE MANAGEMENT SERVICES DEPARTMENT OPERATING BUDGET (ORDINANCE NO. 20130909-001) TO APPROPRIATE ADDITIONAL FUNDS FOR THE INDEPENDENT CITIZENS REDISTRICTING COMMISSION.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AUSTIN:

PART 1. On November 6, 2012, voters approved Proposition No. 3 providing for the election of 10 council members from 10 geographical single member districts, with the mayor to be elected from the city at large, and to provide for an Independent Citizens Redistricting Commission (Commission).

PART 2. City Charter Article 2, Section 3(K)(9) states “the city council shall appropriate sufficient funds to meet the operational cost of the commission.”

PART 3. The Commission has requested an additional \$40,000 from the City for legal services and to retain their Executive Director for an additional two months in order to ensure the completion of the Commission’s final report.

PART 4. The Management Services Department has identified funding within their existing budget for this request.

PART 5. Council amends the Fiscal Year 2014 Operating Budget (Ordinance No. 20130909-001) to deappropriate \$40,000 from the budget of the Management Services Department and to reappropriate those funds to the budget of the Office of the City Clerk for the Commission for legal services and retention of their Executive Director for an additional two months.

PART 6. This ordinance takes effect on _____, 2014.
