Authorize negotiation and execution of an agreement with Staybridge Suites, to provide a performance-based incentive for the generation of solar energy at its facility located at 13000 N IH 35 Svc. Rd. SB, Bldg. 9 in Austin, Texas, for an estimated \$12,152 per year, for a total amount not to exceed \$121,520 over a 10-year period.
- 3. Authorize additional funding to the job order contract with GO GREEN SQUADS, LLC (WBE/FW); MCCULLOUGH HEATING & AIR CONDITIONING, INC.; CLIMATE MECHANICAL, INC., AIRTECH ENERGY SYSTEMS, INC.; GOOD NEIGHBOR MANAGEMENT, INC. DBA CITY CONSERVATION; AND AMERICAN CONSERVATION & AIR, INC., for Austin Energy's Home Efficiency Assistance Program (HEAP) Tier 2 Basic Weatherization Plus HVAC, to be distributed to job order contractors based on work authorization and availability, in an amount not to exceed \$3,400,000.

Authorize execution of a power purchase agreement with Lincoln Renewable Energy LLC, Chicago, IL for a term of up to 18 years for up to 300 megawatts of wind generated electricity, in an estimated amount of \$31,000,000 per year, for an estimated total contract amount of amount of \$558,000,000.
