Cemetery Master Plan Purpose



The Cemetery Master Plan is a roadmap or blueprint for the future. The plan will provide a historic context for the cemeteries, examine the multitude of issues that cemeteries face, establish goals for the future and outline a plan for achieving the goals.



Components of the Master Plan



- Historic context and identification of significant features
- Conditions assessment
- Site analysis, including topography, land use, circulation, vegetation, infrastructure
- Preservation policy recommendations
- Recommendations for new facilities, fencing, monuments
- Analysis of funding model
- Implementation guide
- Comprehensive tree survey






Timeline and Process



- 1991—Outside company contracted to manage all aspects of cemetery operations
- Early 2012—PARB Cemetery
 Working Group meets with
 community to identify concerns
 with cemetery stewardship
- April 1, 2013—PARD assumes management of municipal cemeteries
- Existing conditions include deteriorated buildings and monuments; dead and dying trees; poor road conditions; accessibility issues.






Timeline and Process for Development of Request for Proposal

- June, 2013—PARD holds 4 stakeholder meetings about master plan process and solicits input from community about cemetery needs and goals
- August, 2013—Draft Scope of Work posted and 2 stakeholder meetings held for additional feedback
- September, 2013—Request for Proposals issued
- November, 2013—Evaluation team scores proposals and identifies recommended firm







- February 10, 2014—Action item recommended by Land, Facilities and Programs Committee
- February 25, 2014—Present recommendation to Parks and Recreation Board
- February 27, 2014—Request for Council Action to negotiate, execute, and award contract with Amaterra Environmental, Inc. to develop Cemetery Master Plan



Next steps



- March, 2014—Consultant team begins planning process; process will include robust stakeholder process
- 2014—Implementation of CIP projects including road and irrigation improvements, restoration of Oakwood Chapel and conceptual plans for Austin Memorial Park office
- Early, 2015—Completion of Cemetery Master Plan.
