ACTION ITEM: Review and approve the draft FY15 GATRRS Operating and Capital Budgets (“Exhibit G” to the Interlocal Agreement for the Operation and Maintenance of the Regional Radio System), and recommend approval of these budgets by each GATRRS Party and appropriation of their proportionate shares in their next Fiscal Year’s budgets.
4. ACTION ITEM: Review and discuss a request from Burnet County and GATRRS Western Region coalition members (Blanco, Burnet, Llano Counties) to locate a Western Region radio communications site at the GATRRS site at Singleton Bend.
5. ACTION ITEMS: Review and discuss GATRRS six-year lifecycle project for FY13 through FY18.
  - 5.1. Approve Phase 1 tower-analysis results and the plan to move forward under TIA/EIA engineering standards rev. 222F.
  - 5.2. Approve proposed Phase 2 no-cost change order.
