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### Subject

Authorize award, negotiation, and execution of a 36-month requirements supply contract with LONGHORN INTERNATIONAL TRUCKS LTD, to provide Original Equipment Manufacturer (OEM) and Aftermarket Parts for Navistar Truck Engines in a total amount not to exceed \$2,181,483, with three 12-month extension options in a total amount not to exceed \$727,161 per extension option, for a total contract amount not to exceed \$4,362,966.

### Amount and Source of Funding

Funding in the amount of \$363,581 is available in the Fiscal Year 2013-2014 Operating Budget of the Fleet Services Department. Funding for the remaining 30-months of the original contract period and extension options is contingent upon available funding in future budgets.

No subcontracting opportunities were identified; therefore, no goals were established for this contract.
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### Additional Backup Information

This contract is for the supply of Original Equipment Manufacturer (OEM) and Aftermarket Parts for Navistar engines in the City's fleet. The contractor will provide these captive repair parts for various City-owned vehicles on an as needed basis.

The parts will be used for the daily operations of general routine repair and maintenance services for vehicles equipped with Navistar engines. Work is to be performed by City technicians in five Fleet Service Centers. The City currently has approximately 432 vehicles in the fleet inventory that are equipped with Navistar engines. This contract is necessary to support the automotive and equipment Fleet Service Centers with a reliable and continuous source of supply to purchase these captive repair parts.
