BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AUSTIN:

PART 1. Chapter 12-5 (*Stopping, Standing, and Parking*) of the City Code is amended by adding a new section that reads as follows:

§ 12-6-12 COMMERCIAL VEHICLES LOADING OR UNLOADING FROM A METERED SPACE, COMMERCIAL LOADING ZONE, OR TRAVEL LANE.

- (A) This section applies to commercial vehicles loading or unloading within the Downtown Austin Project Coordination Zone as defined in the Austin Utilities Criteria Manuel Monday through Saturday.
- (B) The director of the Austin Transportation Department may issue a permit to an owner of a commercial vehicle to allow the use of the vehicle to load or unload its cargo from a metered space, commercial loading zone, or curbside travel lanes.
- (C) Permits described in subsection (B) shall be visible in the commercial vehicle at the time of loading or unloading.
- (D) Permits described in subsection (B) will not allow deliveries from locations where there is only a single lane in one direction or from a transit priority lane.
- (E) Fees for these permits will be established by separate ordinance.
