Additional Backup Information

The Austin Regional Intelligence Center (ARIC) is a collaborative effort between partnering agencies providing resources, expertise and/or information to a single center to enhance the ability to detect, prevent and respond to emerging crime trends or potential terrorism activity by linking existing law enforcement data. Partners will include: Austin Community College through its Police Department, Texas State University through its Police Department, the City of Cedar Park through its Police Department, Pflugerville Independent School District through its Police Department, the City of Kyle through its Police Department, and the City of Buda through its Police Department.

By approving this amendment, the City and the other nine original partners authorize the addition of six new partners to the ARIC. The amendment also authorizes the City of Austin to enter into separate agreements with additional partners that are not governmental bodies. Those agencies also perform a law enforcement function and will abide by the same terms as the original partner agencies.
