ORDINANCE NO. 20140417-011

AN ORDINANCE WAIVING THE REQUIREMENTS OF CHAPTER 14 OF THE CITY CODE FOR THE NAMING OF A CITY FACILITY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AUSTIN:

PART 1. The City Council finds that:

- (A) By this action on April 17, 2014, the City Council authorizes the negotiation and execution of an Agreement for Development and Construction of New Cultural Facilities for Public Use Funded in Part with Bond Funds (Agreement) with the Film Society of Austin, Inc. (Austin Film Society), a Texas non-profit corporation.
- (B) The Agreement describes the rights and responsibilities of the City and the Austin Film Society regarding the funding, design, construction, and renovation of existing and new city-owned film studio facilities located on city-owned property located in and around the former National Guard Armory. All of these facilities are leased by the City to Austin Film Society.
- (C) The Agreement grants Austin Film Society the right to contract for and grant sponsorships and naming rights for the new and renovated facilities, subject to certain restrictions.
- PART 2. Council waives the requirements of Chapter 14 of the Austin City Code related to naming a city facility for the new and renovated facilities that will be constructed during the tenancy of the Austin Film Society, subject to review of the names by the designee of the City Manager, ratification of the names that will appear on the exterior of the facilities by City Council, and compliance with the requirements of the Agreement.

PART 3. This ordinance takes effect on April 28, 2014.
