ORDINANCE NO.

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 2-1 OF THE CITY CODE REGARDING CITY <u>BOARDSCOMMISSION</u>; AND PROVIDING FOR A TRANSITION FROM A SEVEN-MEMBER COUNCIL TO AN 11-MEMBER COUNCIL WITH REGARD TO <u>BOARD-COMMISSION</u> MEMBERSHIP AND APPOINTMENTS.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AUSTIN:

- PART 1. Board-Commission Transition.
 - (A) In this Part "boardcommission" means:
 - (1) a board or commission named in Chapter 2-1 of the City Code and:
 - (a) the Austin Area Comprehensive HIV Planning Council;
 - (b) the Impact Fee Advisory Committee; and
 - (c) the Urban Renewal Authority.
 - (B) Beginning on the first date that the city council elected in the November 2014 general election convenes:
 - (1) the size, composition, officers, committees, and bylaws of each board commission are continued as each of these exist until June 30, 2015;
 - (2) unless otherwise required by state law or the City Charter a quorum of a boardcommission, and the number of votes required for action by the boardcommission, is a majority of the members, not including a member who has died, been removed, or resigned unless that member is serving in a hold-over capacity; and
 - (3) unless otherwise required by state law or the City Charter:
 - (a) the term of each <u>current</u> council appointee on a <u>board commission</u> is extended to June 30, 2015; and
 - (b) the term of each <u>current</u> council appointee on a <u>board commission</u> expires on June 30, 2015.
 - (C) If a vacancy exists on a board commission after the last regularly scheduled meeting of the seven-member at-large city council; the vacancy shall be filled Page 1 of 3

by the council elected at the November 2014 general election. The Mayor shall nominate a person to fill the vacancy, subject to the council's approval. Unless otherwise required by state law or the City Charter, a term of a person appointed to fill a vacancy under this subpart expires on June 30, 2015.

- (D) A council member elected at the November 2014 election who will be entitled to nominate a person for appointment to a board commission under Chapter 2-1 as amended by Part 2 of this ordinance may nominate a person before the effective date of Part 2, and the council may make appointment a person who is nominated before the effective date of Part 2, provided:
 - (1) the appointment is not effective, and the person appointed may not assume the office before the effective date of Part 2; and
 - (2) before the effective date of Part 2, a person appointed shall, unless this requirement is waived by the City Clerk, complete the training required under Chapter 2-1. A waiver granted by the City Clerk ends on the effective date of Part 2.
- (2)—(E) Council may sit any commission prior to the July 1 date to replace the existing commission and establish an effective date earlier than July 1 for the individual commission upon approval of the Council.

PART 2. Section 2-1-4 of the City Code is amended to read:

§ 2-1-4 SIZE AND APPOINTMENT.

- (A) Except as otherwise provided in Article 2 (*Boards*), a board commission consists of 11 [seven] members appointed by the city council.
- (B) For a board commission with 11 [seven] or more members, each council member shall nominate one board membercommissioner to serve on the board commission, and the mayor shall nominate the other board memberscommissioners.
- (C) For a board commission with fewer than 11 [seven] members, the mayor shall nominate the board members commissioners.
- (D) All appointments of board commissioners members are subject to approval by a majority vote of council.
