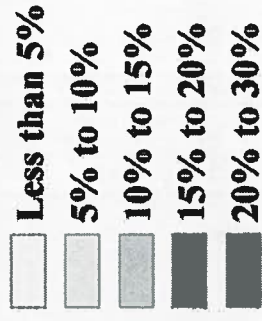


Mayor's Race Results: Percent Turnout

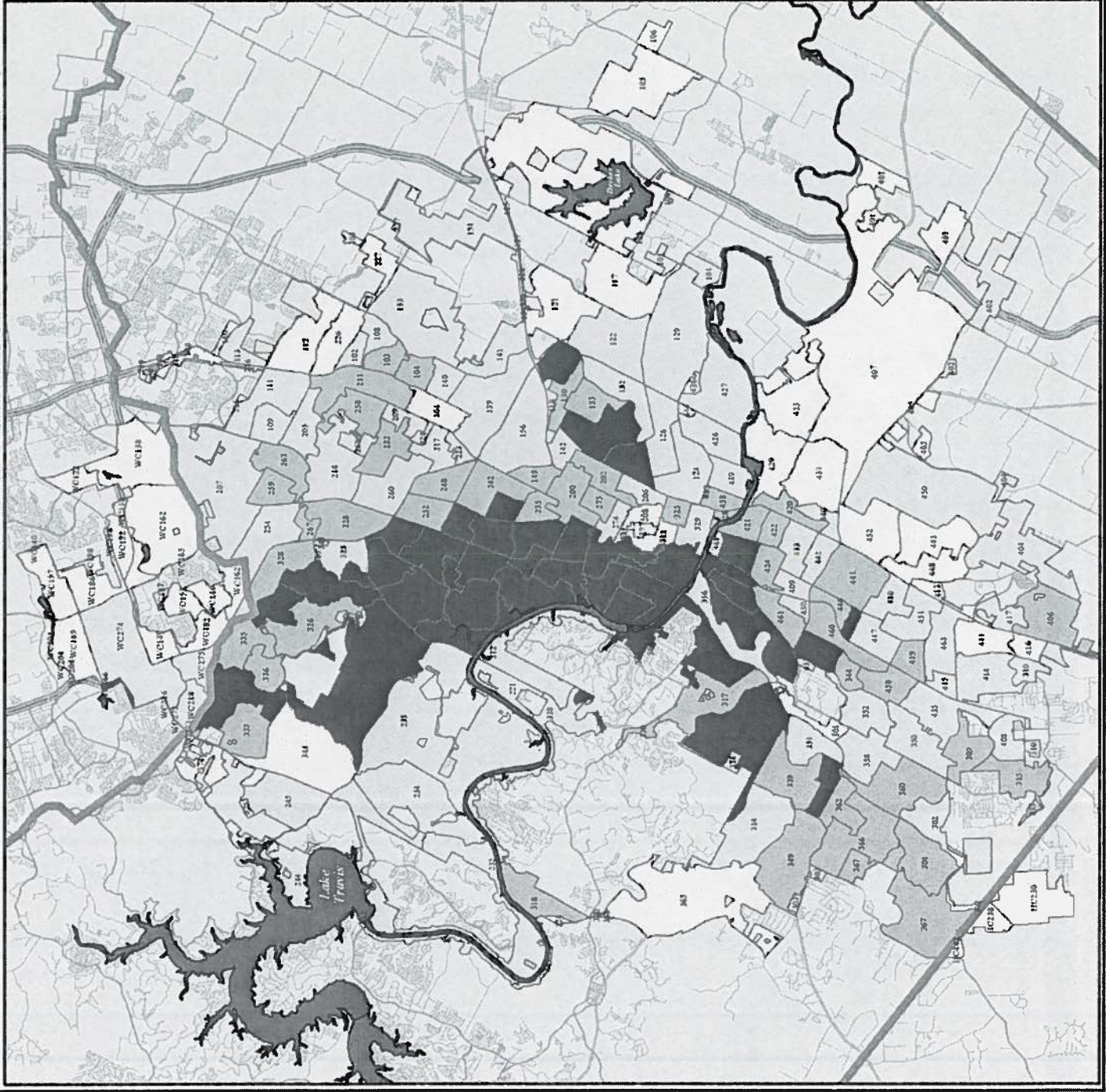

Mayor's Race Results: Total Votes May 12, 2012 City of Austin.

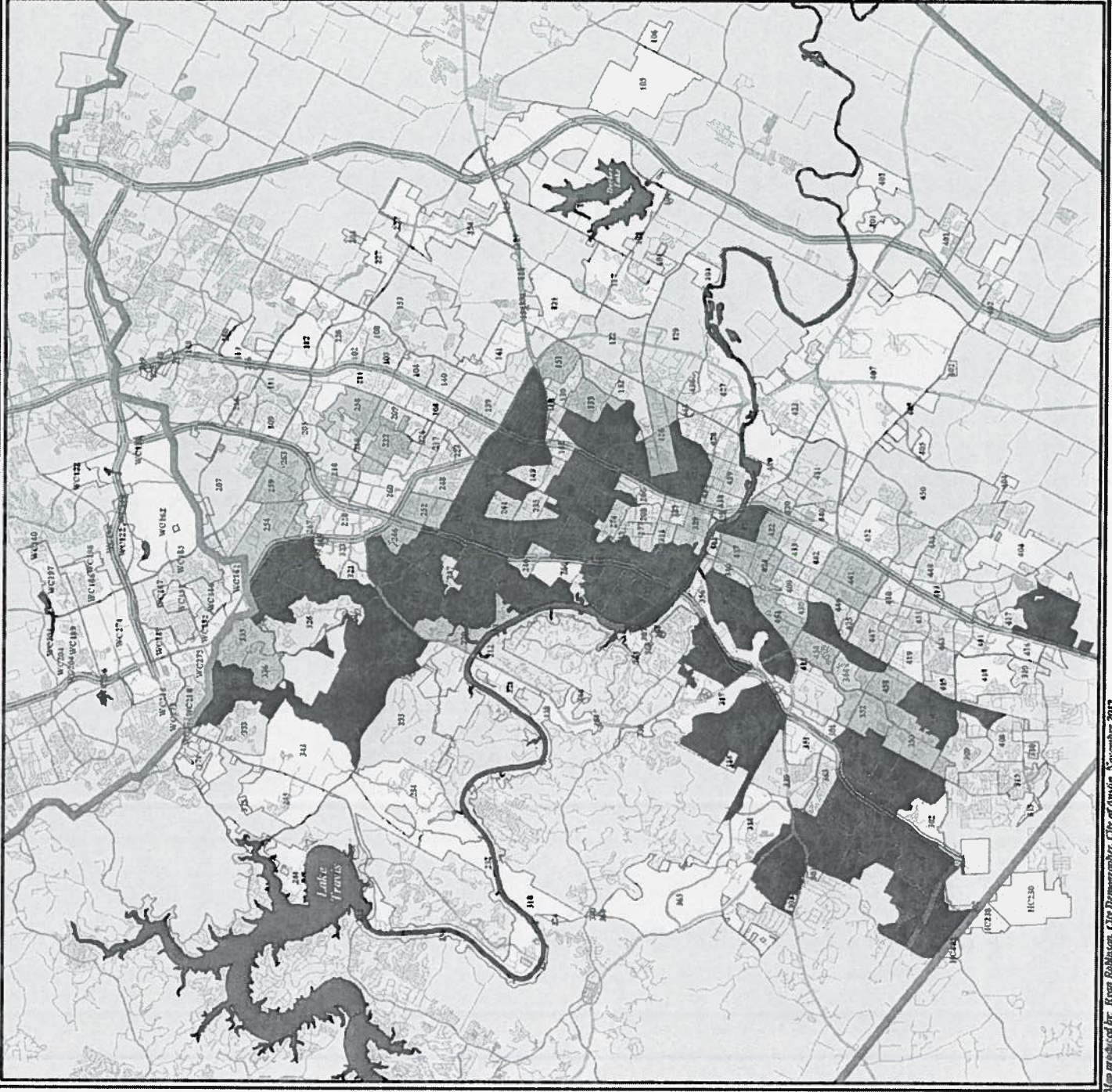

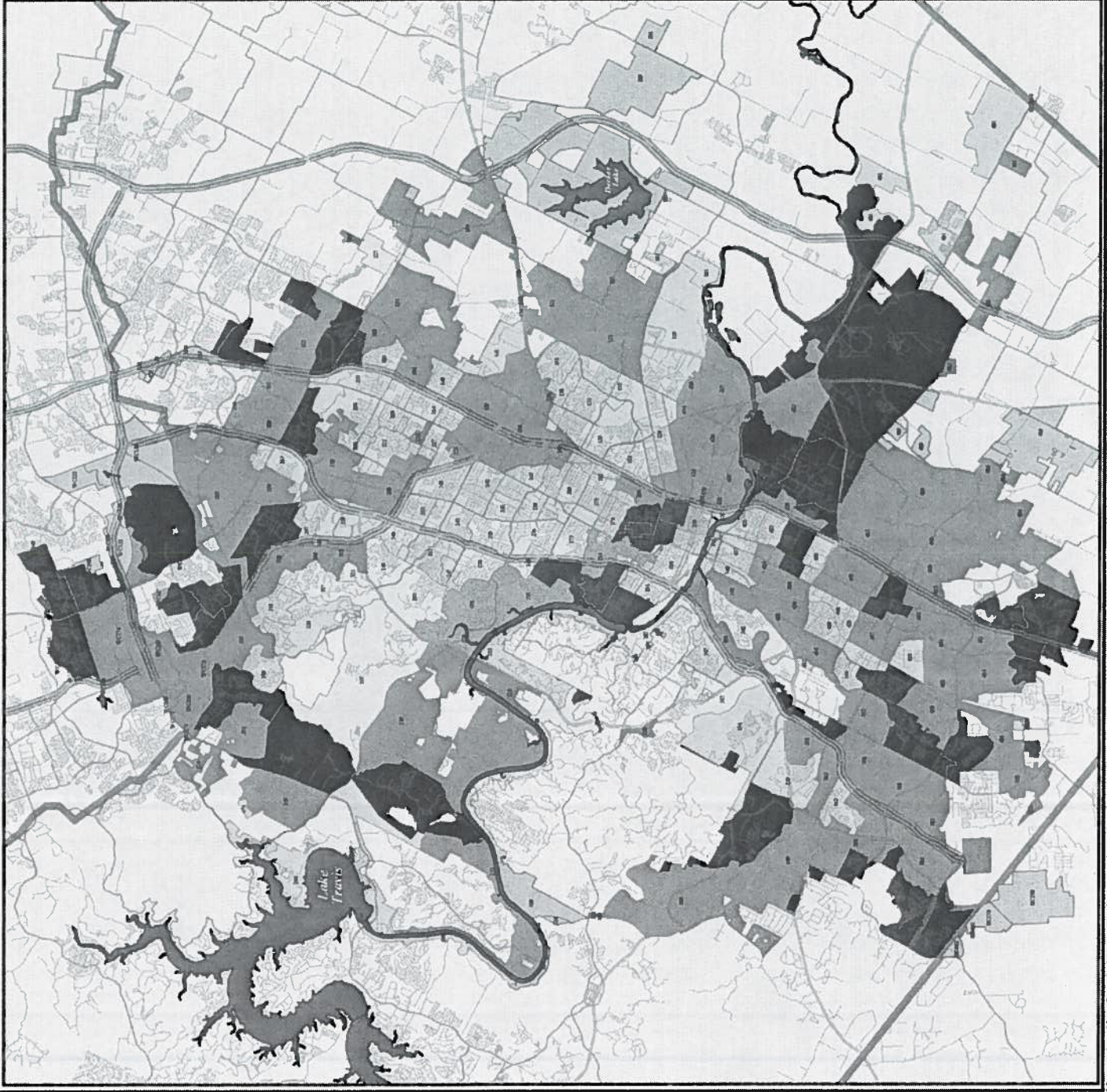
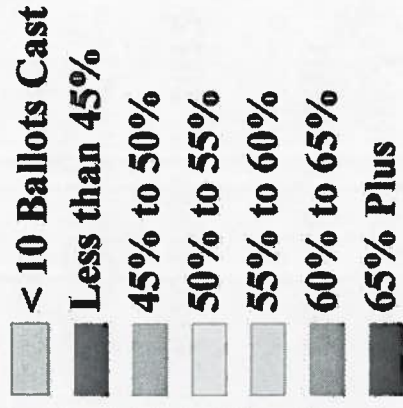

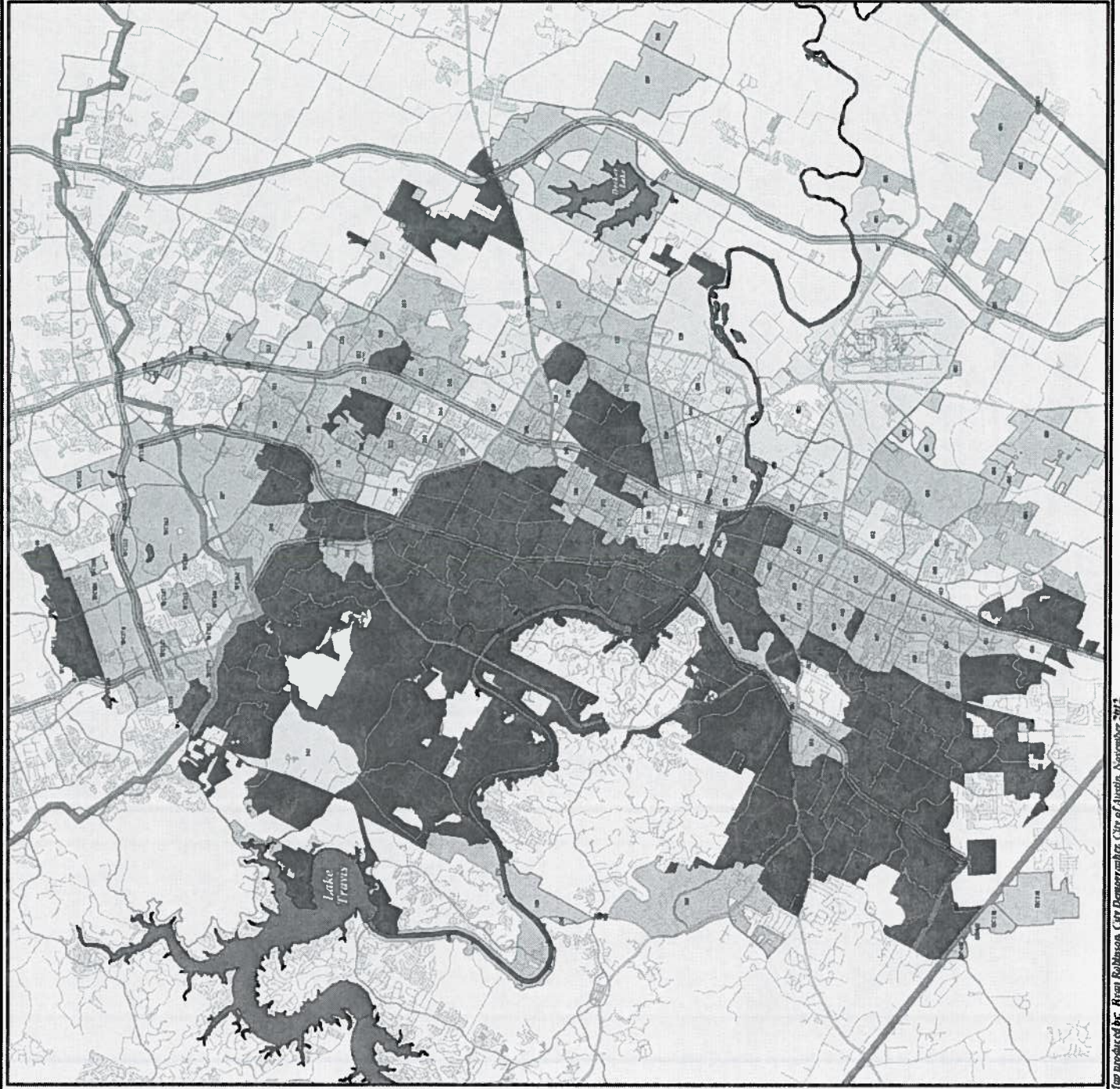
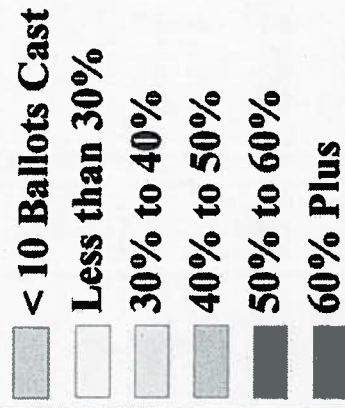
Voter Turnout: Proposition 3, The 10-1 Plan

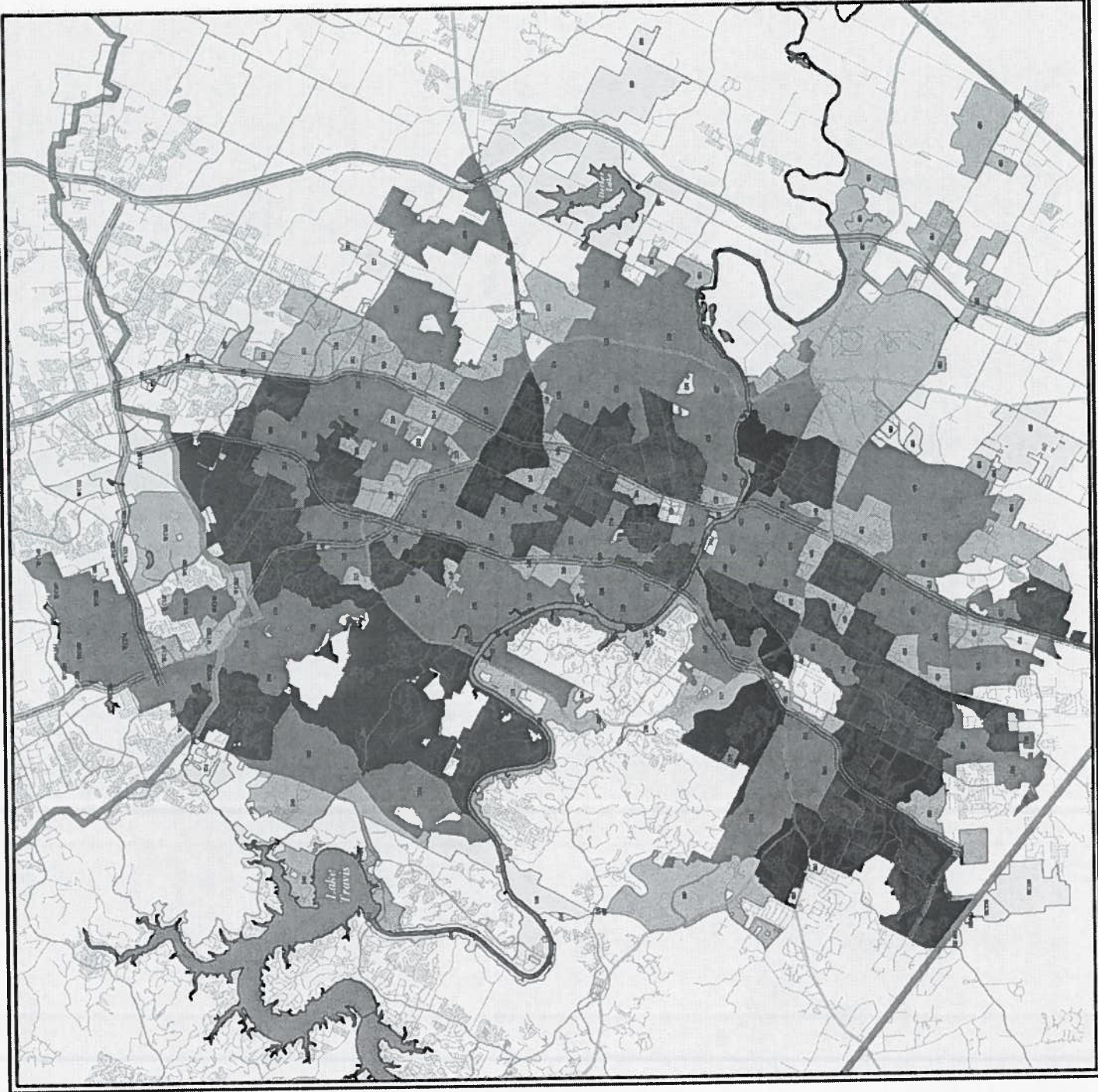
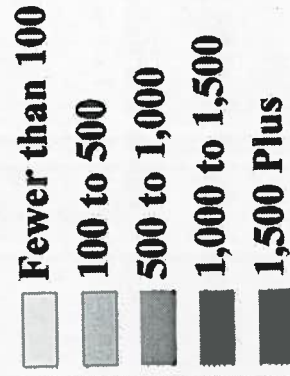

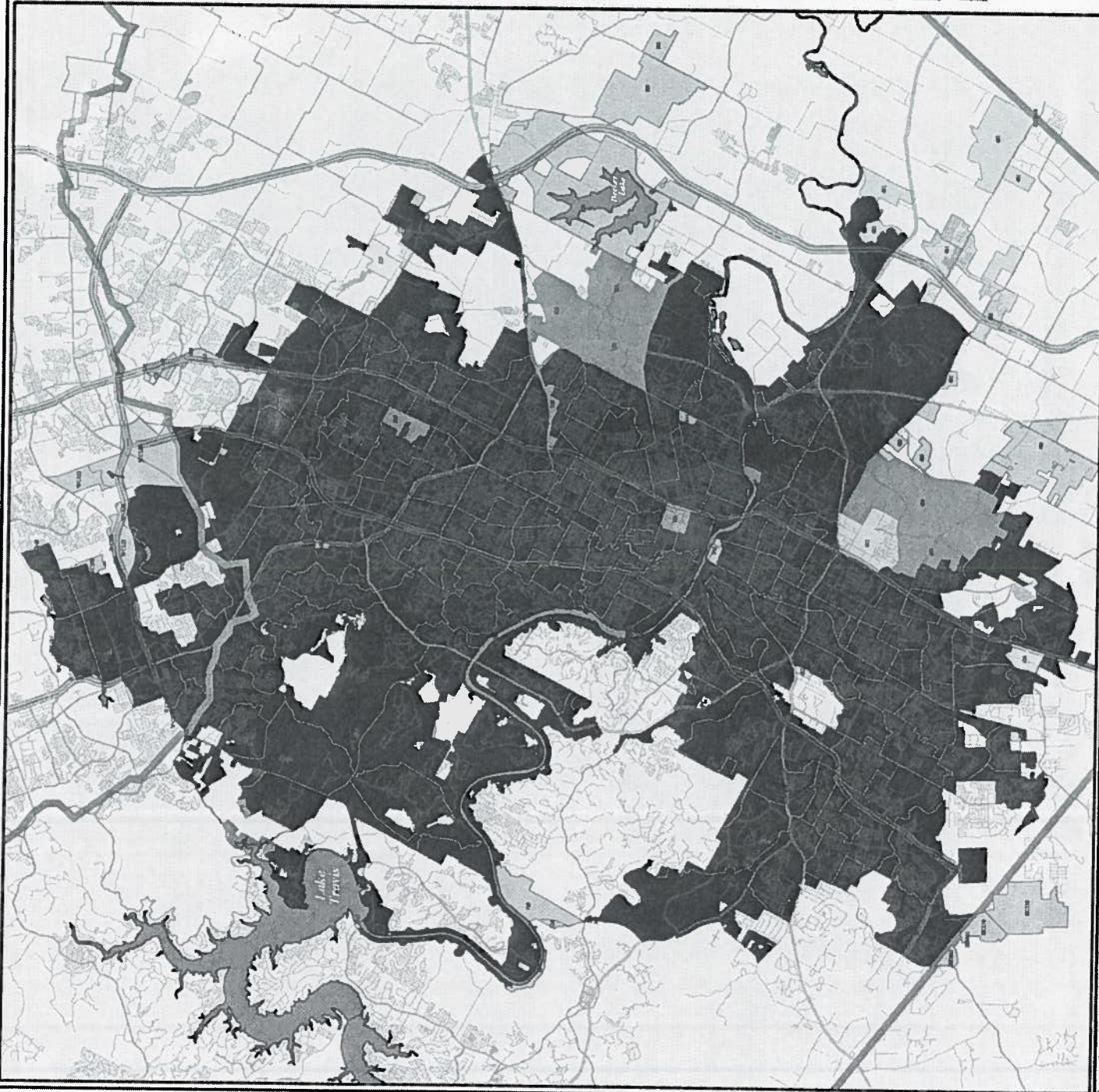
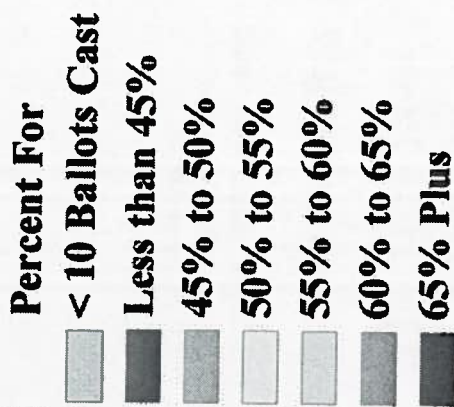


Proposition 1 Results: Move Council Elections to November
