PROPOSAL

Demolish a ca. 1951 house.

ARCHITECTURE

One-story, rectangular-plan, side-gabled frame house with a partial-width, shed-roofed independent entry hood on ornamental metal posts; single and paired 6:6 modern vinyl replacement windows; one-story, rectangular-plan, shed-roofed addition to the rear.

RESEARCH

The house was built as a rental unit by Kurt E. Buettner, a local real estate agent, in the winter of 1950-51. The first tenants were Louis and Lucille Rubino, who lived here until around 1954; Louis Rubino was in the U.S. Army. Enrique C. and Julia Lopez purchased the house around 1954; Enrique Lopez was a meter repairman for Hamilton Electric Works on Red River Street; his daughter, Herminia "Minnie" Lopez lived in the house from the early 1970s until her death in 1997. She was an office secretary, who worked for the State Department of Health, the University of Texas, and for over 30 years, as the secretary to U.S. Congressman Jake Pickle.

STAFF COMMENTS

The house does not appear in any City survey.

STAFF RECOMMENDATION

Recommend re-use of the house if feasible; while rather late for the neighborhood, the house represents a typical housing type of the Holly Street area of East Austin. If re-use of the house is not possible, then recommend relocation over demolition, but release the permit upon completion of a City of Austin Documentation Package, consisting of photographs of all elevations, a dimensioned sketch plan, and a narrative history, for archiving at the Austin History Center.
